Revenue from this fund raiser is provided to the Kiwanis Student Assistance Program administered by the Family Conservancy. There are currently 28 students enrolled in the program and a waiting list.

The program serves disadvantaged youth who through no fault of their own are unable to live with their parents who provide living environments marked by verbal, sexual and physical abuse, neglect, abandonment and drug and alcohol abuse issues. These adolescents are living with extended family, friends or on their own and are continuing to pursue a high school diploma. The Student Assistance Program provides these students financial support, counseling and individual case-management services. Students must maintain a "C" average, work part time and or participate in school sponsored sports or activities in order to receive the full support of the program.

Kiwanis and the Student Assistance program provide support across the Kansas City Metropolitan area. The following is a breakdown of the schools where the participating students attend and the current # at each location:
